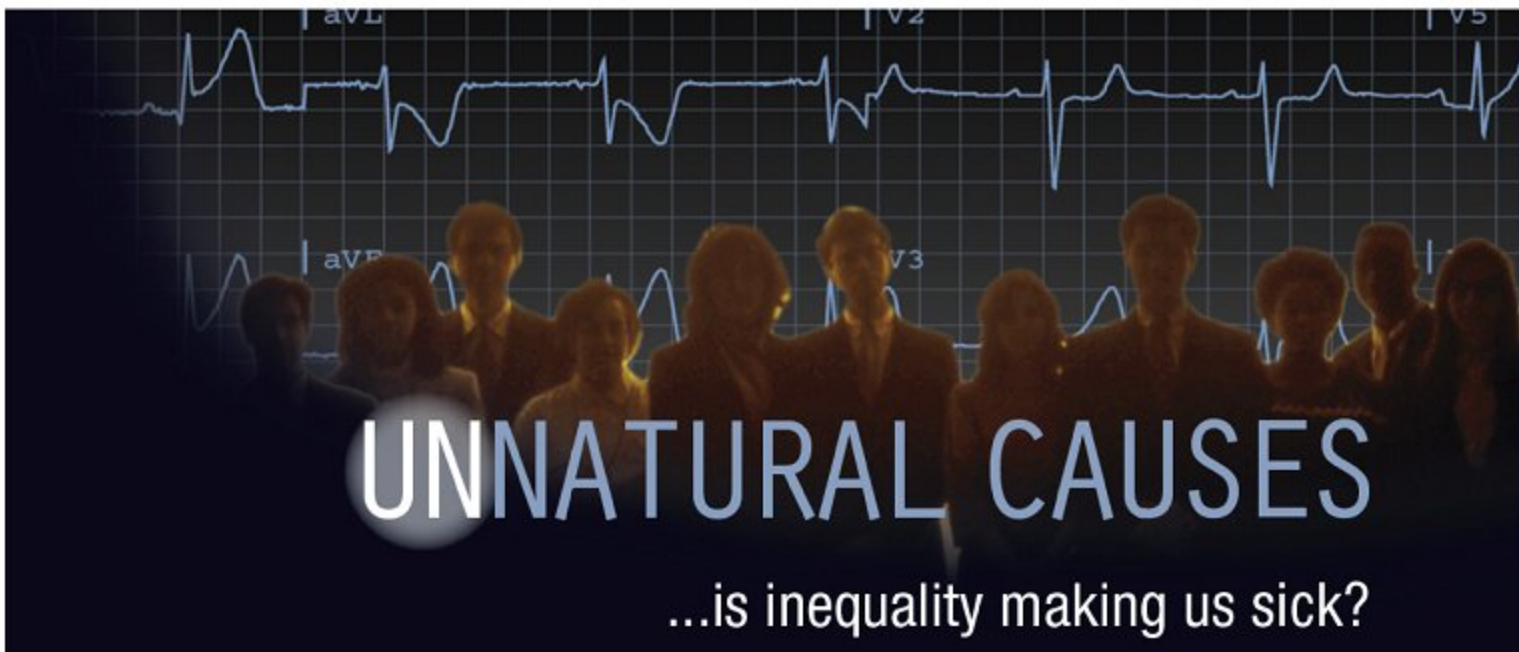

Santa Clara County Public Health Department and The Health Trust invite you to a special community screening of the PBS documentary "Unnatural Causes, In Sickness and in Wealth". This thought-provoking film explores evidence that some of the most powerful determinants of health are socioeconomic factors such as income level, race, and zip code.

Following the screening there will be a panel discussion. Dr. Fenstersheib, our County Health Officer and Acting Public Health Director, will start the discussion with a look at health inequities in Santa Clara County as well as next steps to promote health as a social justice issue.

The Health Trust will also be announcing a special mini-grants strategy at this event focused on encouraging local organizations to screen parts or all of the Unnatural Causes series with their own targeted audiences. The grants will be used to support dissemination of the Unnatural Causes series and to initiate dialogue throughout the community about health inequities.
