Our report shows that where you live makes a big influence on how long you live. Is it fair that if your address is in West Oakland, your sons and daughters will live, on average, 10 years less than if your address is in the Berkeley Hills? Is it fair that if you live in Bay View/Hunters Point your children will live, on average, 14 years less than if your address is on Russian Hill? This can't be acceptable. Every local jurisdiction, including health departments, should do whatever is in their power to rectify these differences. Where you live should not determine how long you live.
